Green Spaces Program Volunteer Opportunity

Drivers

General Program Information:

Peace Ranch has two programs that support people living with serious mental illness that on occasion require transportation Housing Support and Green Spaces Day Program.

The Housing Support program provides housing and 24 hour counselling for 10 residents. Residents work on their recovery process by practicing daily living activities, house and barn chores.

The Green Spaces program provides meaningful activities for residents and day participants to develop inter-personal, social, recreational and vocational skills. We encourage participants to choose various therapeutic activities such as horticulture, farm animal care and/or creative arts during program hours.

Drivers Description:

Volunteer Drivers would provide our residents transportation to local services during the evening and/or on weekends. For example to a fitness program.

Volunteer Drivers would provide our Green Spaces participants a return trip from their home to the Ranch.

Volunteer Drivers are reimbursed for their mileage \$0.40/km

Skills Required:

- Have an understanding of and are comfortable working with the client population or willingness to learn.
- A clean driver's abstract (we reimburse you)
- \$1 000,000 liability insurance/well maintained vehicle
- Police Reference Check (we reimburse you)

Hours of Work:

Wednesdays 8:15 am – 10:00 am 3:00pm – 4:30pm

Evenings and Weekends drive to Caledon, Orangeville or Bolton Areas

Time Commitment:

We would appreciate a 1 year commitment but primarily it is needed for a certain activity the resident has signed up for. (for example: an 8 week swim lesson session)
