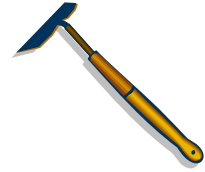

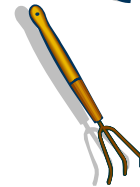
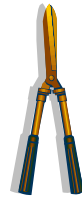
Garden/Green House Assistant Description:

Volunteers assist staff with setting up, facilitating and clean-up of activities.

Depending on the project you may work one on one or with a small group of no more than 3-4 participants.

Skills Required:

- Basic horticulture skills and knowledge (the more the better!)
- Have an understanding of and are comfortable working with the client population or willingness to learn.
- Ability to take direction well and be self-motivated to carry out said directions.
- Willingness to obtain a Police Reference Check (we reimburse you)

Wednesdays & Thursdays from 10:00am to 12:00pm or 1:30pm-3:30pm
Weekends 1-2 hours either day

Seasonal Spring/Summer: 6 months

Fall/Winter: 6 months or longer
